A ship like this deserves a new life as a live aboard, a recreational vessel or perhaps as a workshop, but with preservation of her character. The current owner is active in inland shipping and very experienced in ship repairs. He has already carried out a lot of work. Much of the steelwork has been professionally restored and the ship has already been partly insulated with 20 cm of rock wool. This project has so far been approached with care, focusing on comfort and sustainability. Six water tanks are ready to be installed. The double glazing for the six windows is already available. The engine, currently being overhauled, will be delivered in working condition. The seller will not complete the project due to personal circumstances but a solid foundation has been laid. This is a project for an enthusiast who wants to finish the ship with an eye for quality and tradition. An unique opportunity to complete a piece of history with a forward-looking vision, according to one's own design.
